The YWCA Prevention Education Team provides child assault prevention education to students in grades K-8 and, Sexual Assault Awareness in grades 9-12. We deliver our programs to students in 75 DuPage County Schools throughout the school year.

Our prevention education work schedule coincides with the DuPage County school year. A volunteer must be available during the school week when children are in classes. In order deliver prevention education, the 40-hour Rape Crisis Training and the Child Assault Prevention Training are mandatory.

- We are looking for individuals who can commit to at 2-3 flexible days a week.
- Schedules are prepared one month in advance to allow for flexibility.
- Must have a reliable means of transportation.
- Many volunteers have transitioned into paid YWCA staff.
- We are looking to expand our bi-lingual team.
